### **2023 Annual Fish Derby Things you want to know.**

Q: When is the derby?

A: Labour Day Sat & Sun – Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>

Q: Where do I purchase tickets?

A: Bradley's Bait & Tackle, Kitimat Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Centre, MK Bay Marina & Ron's Bait & Tackle

Q: How much are tickets?

A: Adult tickets are \$20 +gst = \$21 and Youth are \$10 + gst = \$10.50

Q: What is the age range for youth this year? I hear there was a change.

A: This year the youth tickets are for 12 & under

Q: Where is the weigh-in locations this year?

A: Kitimat Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Centre -2109 Forest Ave Sat 10 am-8 pm Sun 10 am-6 pm & MK Bay Marina Sat & Sun from 2 pm-5 pm. **FINAL WEIGH-IN IS 6 PM ON SUNDAY AT THE CHAMBER**

Q: What are the prizes?

A: Prizes are coming in daily for the raffle portion so you will see when you get here. For the actual derby, we have more prizes and more \$\$\$ thanks to all our sponsors, especially Ledcor. We are doing a new fishing prize structure for this year.

Adult 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$1750 + rod & reel, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$1000 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$500.

Youth 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$250 + rod & reel 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$100 + a prize 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$50 + a prize.

We will also have 10 hidden weight prizes for \$250 each as well as the Finley prize that will be given to the youngest girl who fishes. (if there are more than one female with the same age, we will draw names)

Q: What if my business wants to donate a prize for the derby?

Q: If I don't want to fish can I still purchase tickets for the prizes?



**CONDITIONS OF THE 36TH ANNIVERSARY KITIMAT FISHING DERBY**

- Tickets must be purchased prior to the Fishing Derby Days.
- All entries must be caught during the Derby Days, on the Kitimat River or the Douglas Channel (Zone 6).
- All Federal and Provincial Fishing Regulations apply.
- Ticket must be shown at time of weigh-in with dressed (gutted & gilled) fish.
- One weigh-in per ticket.
- **Weigh In** at the Kitimat Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Centre on Saturday from 10:00am to 8:00pm and Sunday from 10:00am to 6:00pm.
- **Weigh In** at MK Bay Marina on Saturday and Sunday from 2:00pm to 5:00pm.

Major Prizes will be presented, *in person*, on **Sunday September 3RD 2023 at 7:00pm** at the Kitimat Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Center.

Random prizes will be drawn over the 2 days with winners posted on site and on social media. Please make sure your contact information is clearly printed on your ticket. Prizes must be claimed with your Fishing Derby Ticket at the Kitimat Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Center during the draws or in our office from September 5 to 15, 2023 8:30am to 4:30pm (closed on weekends). If prizes are not picked up and no contact has been made with us by the Sept 15th, we will redraw.

Q: Is there parking available?

A: Parking is very limited so carpool or take us up on our offer for the FREE SHUTTLE thanks to First Transit Canada Inc/Transat

Q: Are you having the free shuttle again this year?

A: Yes, the shuttle will begin at 5 pm. Pick up for the shuttle will be in the "Upper City Mall" parking lot near the Trigo's, look for the signage.
